THE APPLICANT FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGES the requirement of Article 17 of North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 66, and CERTIFIES that the proposed sale will be conducted only as permitted and required by law. Violation of this Article constitutes a misdemeanor, punishable by fine and/or imprisonment up to two years as set forth in N.C.G.S. §66-77(d).
