Statesville Connects is a voluntary assistance program funded by donations from Statesville utility customers and other individuals/organizations. The City is working with the Statesville Salvation Army, a non-profit organization that provides emergency assistance for low income families and people in crisis. Only Statesville residential utility customers who meet the Salvation Army's requirements will receive assistance with their bills.

How can I help?

You can help by adding \$1, \$5 or more to your monthly utility bill. Simply check a box and this amount will automatically be added to your monthly utility bill. Monthly contributions will remain in effect until you notify customer service to discontinue.

You can also write a separate check to the **Statesville Connects** Program.

Is my donation tax deductible?

Contributions to the **Statesville Connects** Program may be tax deductible. The City will provide you with annual statements documenting your total donation.
