IECCR RIDER

INDUSTRIAL EXCESS CAPACITY CREDIT RIDER

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**AVAILABILITY**

This Industrial Excess Capacity Credit Rider is available only to customers meeting the following requirements:

1. Industrial customers receiving service under the City's Very Large Industrial Customer Incentive (VI) Rate for new or expanded industrial loads. The availability of credits under this Rider is contingent upon the Customer load meeting the minimum eligibility requirements for service under the then-effective VI Rate schedule except as modified by this rider. These modifications are: within three (3) years from the first date of service, an average monthly on-peak demand must meet or exceed 2 MW on a rolling twelve-month basis unless the Customer has technical, operational, or financial problems that would reasonably prevent the Customer from such operation (Customer must notify the City in writing immediately); within eight (8) years from the first date of service, the annual peak demand must meet or exceed 3 MW. These provisions allow more time for the Customer to reach a 3 MW demand than a customer on the VI rate without this Rider.
2. Load to receive this credit must not have been served by the City or any North Carolina Municipal Power Agency Number 1 (NCMPA-1) participant prior to the date, on which service of this load under the VI Rate (and associated Service Agreement) is to commence. A change in ownership of an existing establishment does not constitute a new load. If a change in ownership occurs during the contracted execution of this Rider, the succeeding owner may be allowed to fulfill the balance of the contract.
3. Load to receive this credit must be metered separately from all other Customer load.
4. Customer shall have entered into a Service Agreement with City for service under the VI Rate ("VI Rate Service Agreement") prior to the date on which such service is to commence.
5. Load must not be a municipal load.

Any customer desiring to receive service under this Rider shall provide written notification to the City of such desire. Such notice shall provide the City with information concerning the load to be served and the Customer's facilities and shall provide the basis for the City representation that the characteristics of the load will meet the minimum eligibility requirements.

All terms and conditions of Very Large Industrial Customer Incentive (VI) Rate Schedules shall apply to service supplied to the Customer except as modified by this Rider. All service under this Rider shall be subject to the policies, rules and regulations of the City of Statesville as defined in Statesville's Services Policy.

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**MONTHLY CREDIT**

The Customer will receive a Monthly Credit on the bill calculated on the then-effective VI Rate. The schedule of Monthly Credits will be calculated as described below under the heading "Application of Credit."

**APPLICATION OF CREDIT**

Beginning with the date on which service under the then-effective VI Rate Schedule is to commence for the eligible load, a Monthly Credit based on the following rate multiplied by the on- peak demand kW of the new load as measured will be applied to the total monthly bill,

Excess Capacity Credit	\$ 1.75 per On-Peak kW
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**CONTRACT PERIOD**

Customers receiving service under this Rider will be subject to a ten-year contract period.

**ADOPTED**

This Rider was established by City of Statesville Resolution Number 29-16, which was adopted on October 17, 2016. The Rider shall be effective for qualifying customers receiving permanent new load electrical service on or after January 1, 2017. The Excess Capacity Credits will discontinue at midnight on December 31, 2021.
