



Board/Commission Information

Statesville Citizens are appointed to serve on a variety of commissions and committees that are very important to the working of our City. ABC Board

Meets monthly at the ABC Store. Members are appointed for 3-year terms by Mayor & Council, Sec. 6.1 of the City Charter.

Airport Commission

Meets 2nd Thursday of each month at the Statesville Regional Airport in the FBO Conference Room at noon. Members are appointed for 3-year terms by City Council. Recommends broad policies that affect the care and maintenance of the airport.

Board of Adjustment

Meets as needed in the City Hall Council Chambers at 12:30 p.m. Members are appointed for 3-year terms by City Council. Quasi-judicial body which meets to consider appeals of Planning staff orders or decisions, as well as requests for variances from the regulations confined within the Zoning Ordinance.

Civil Service Board

Meets as needed. Members are appointed for 3-year terms by Senior Resident Judge.

Community Appearance Commission

Meets 3rd Thursday of each month in the Recreation & Parks administrative conference room at 12pm. Appointed by Mayor for 3-year terms. Initiates, promotes and assists in the implementation of programs of general community beautification in the city.

Convention & Visitors Bureau

Statesville Convention and Visitors Bureau meet the 3rd Tuesday of each month. City Council appoints Board members for a 4-year term. The CVB is responsible for supporting and promoting tourism in Statesville.

Design Review Committee

Meets on the 2nd Thursday of each month at 2:00 p.m. in the 3rd Floor Conference Room at City Hall. Applicants must be either a business owner or own property in the CB, CBP or the Municipal Service District. Terms are for either 2 years or 3 years depending on the spot they are filling, all staggered. The Design Review Committee reviews applications from property owners for permits to make certain kinds of exterior changes within the CB, CBP or Downtown Tax District Area.

Historic Preservation Commission

Meets 4th Thursday of the month in the 3rd Floor Conference Room at City Hall at 7:00 p.m. The Commission has nine members that are appointed for 3-year terms by the Statesville City Council. The Commission reviews exterior changes, new construction, demolition and significant changes to landscaping to ensure that alterations are in compliance with Statesville Design Guidelines and are compatible with the historic character of the neighborhood. Members should have a demonstrated special interest, experience or education in history, architecture, archaeology or other preservation-related fields.

Planning Board

Meets 4th Tuesday of each month in the City Hall Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m. Members appointed for 3-year terms by City Council (6) and County Commissioners (2). Reviews and makes recommendations on planning policies, ordinances, and procedures; advises City Council on the means for carrying out these plans; considers Zoning Ordinance text changes, changes in the zoning designation of properties; major development proposals and major subdivisions of property.

Statesville Housing Authority

Mayor appoints for 5-year terms. Administer community development and revitalization services.

Stormwater Advisory Committee

Meets the 3rd Thursday of each month. Members are appointed for 3-year staggered terms by City Council. This Commission will become educated and knowledgeable about stormwater in Statesville to evaluate a stormwater utility and its formulation. This Commission will bring a citizen's perspective to the Commission, City staff and Council on related stormwater management issues as they affect stormwater quantity, quality, the City and its citizens.
